Firearms Act 1968 Section 21 Declaration

Explanation: It is an offence for someone who is prohibited by section 21 to have a firearm or ammunition in his possession at any time. Section 21 applies to anybody who has been sentenced to imprisonment or to youth custody or detention in a youth offender institution for three months or more. The period for which they are prohibited depends on their length of sentence - if the sentence was longer than three years, the prohibition is for life. If the sentence was three months or more, but less than three years, the prohibition lasts for five years from the date of their release. It is an offence for a person to transfer, let or hire, give or lend a firearm or ammunition to someone whom he knows or has reasonable ground for believing to be prohibited by section 21.

The above explanation is taken from a Home Office document giving explanatory notes for amendments to the approval criteria for rifle and pistol clubs (the amendments to take force from 1st January 1996).
